

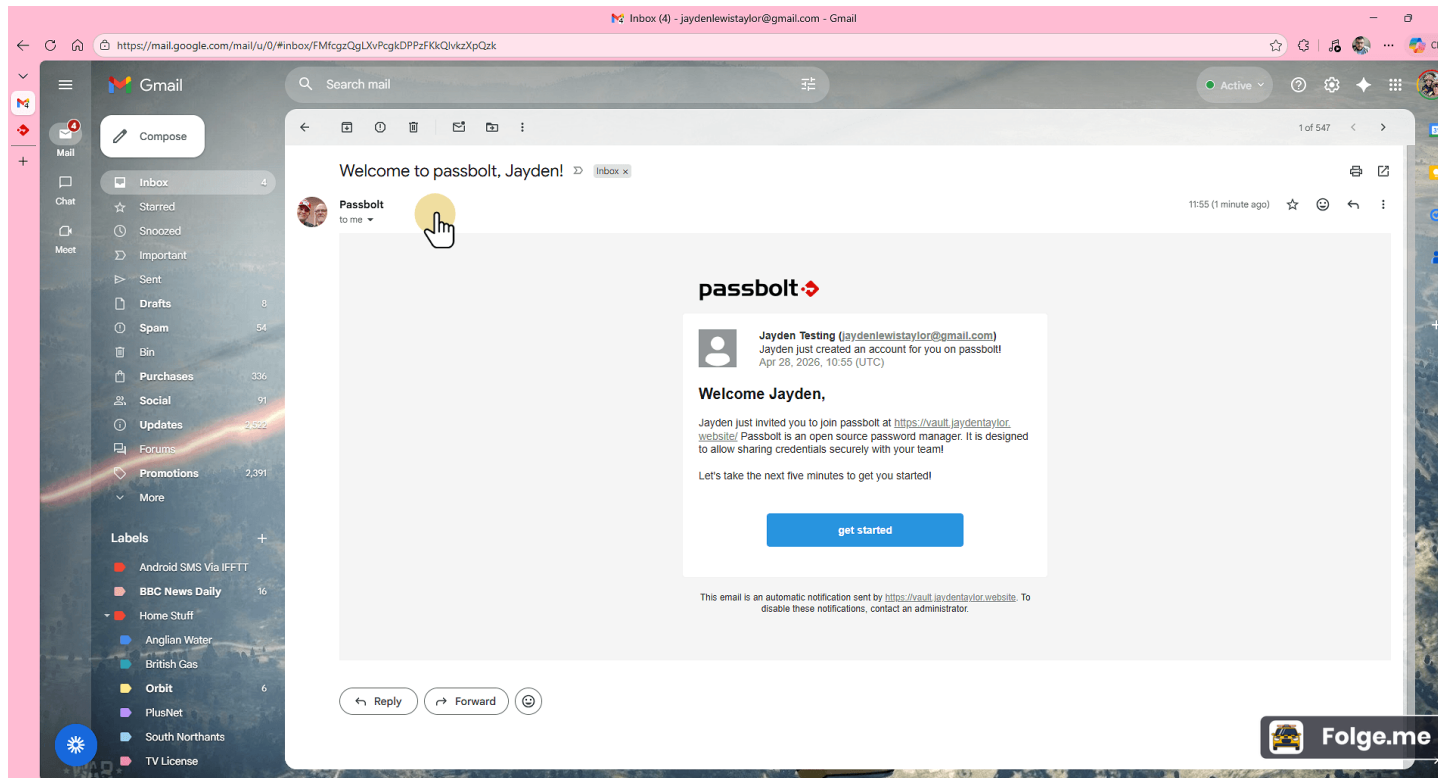

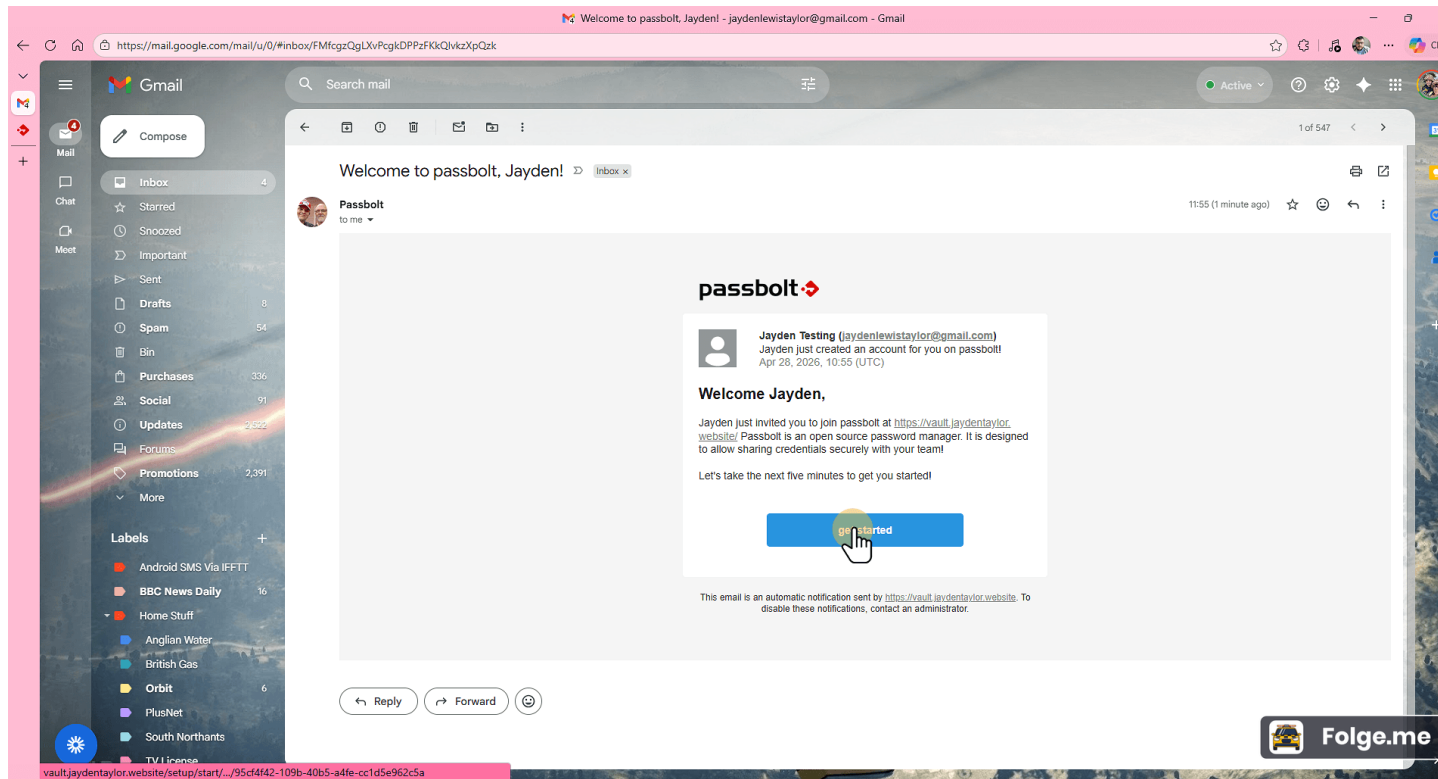
# 1 Click Welcome Email

Once you have received a invite email, then open it.



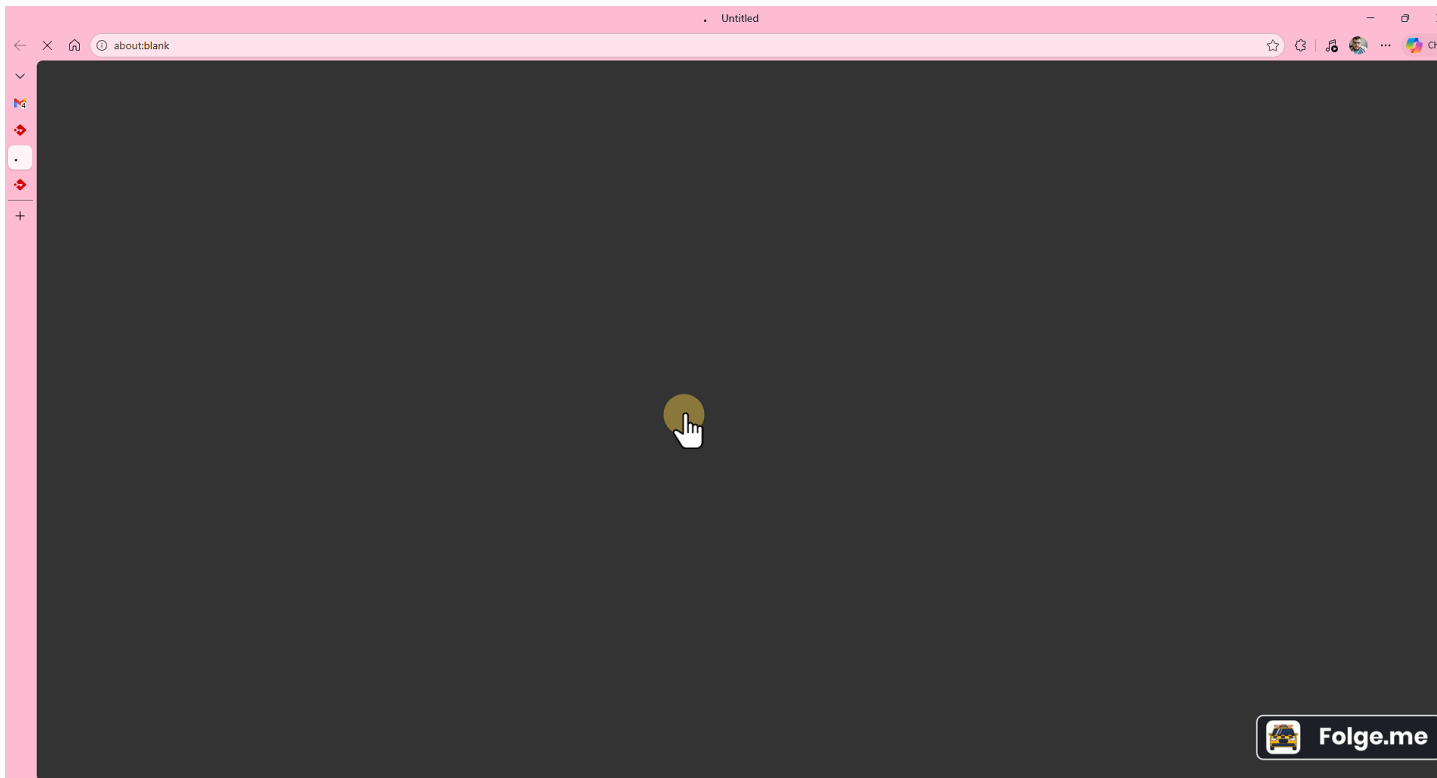
## 2 Get Started Link

Click on the get started link, to begin the passbolt sign-up.



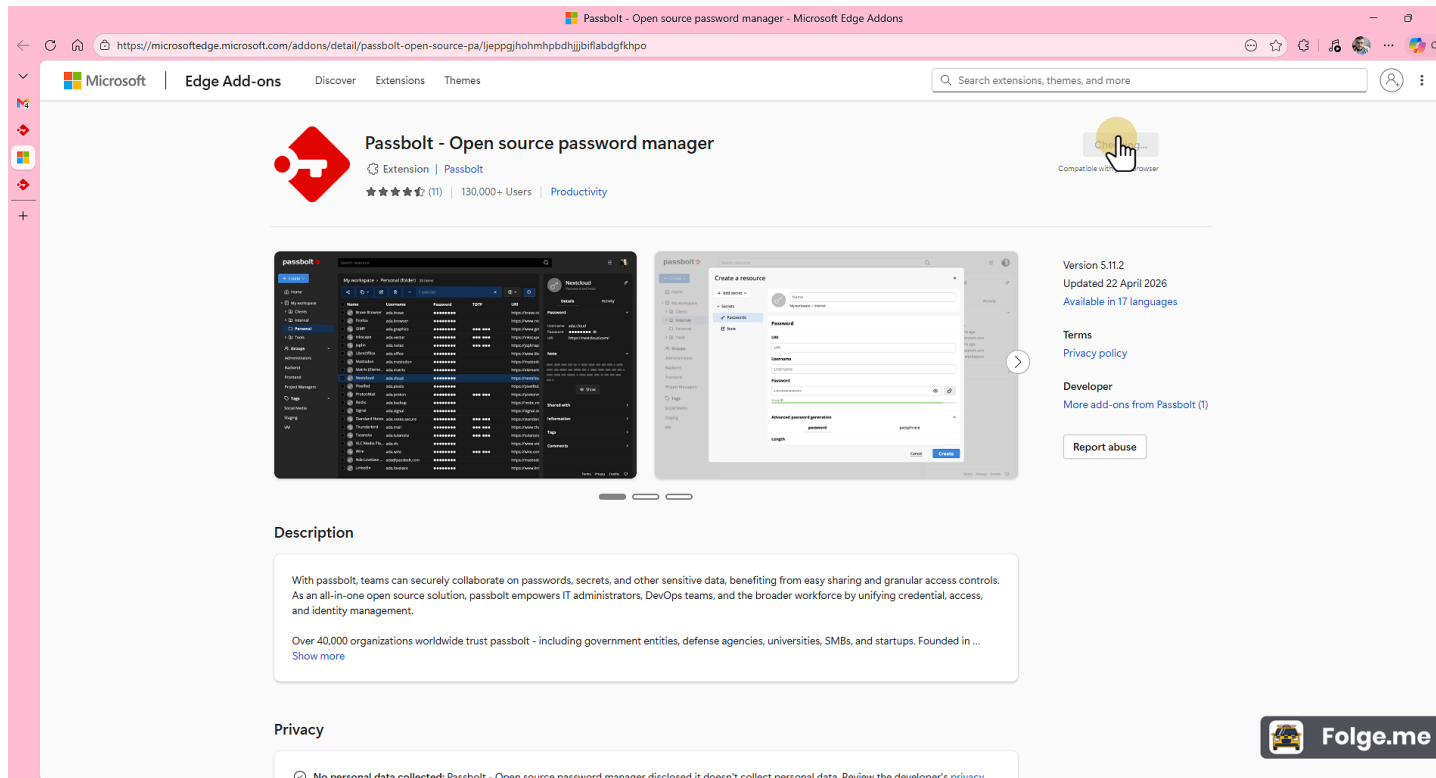
### 3 Extension

When it asks you to install an extension, follow the link to install for your browser.




## 4 Store Install

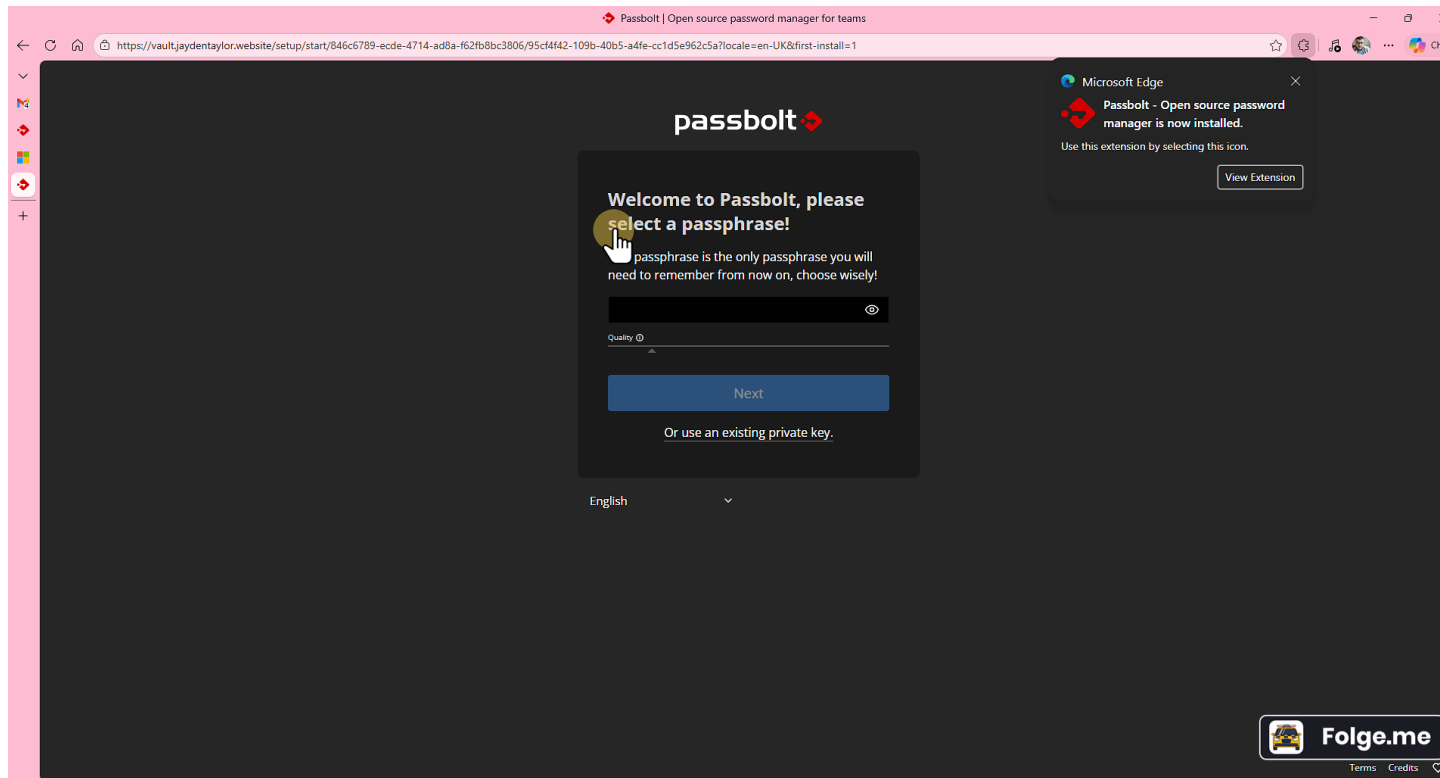

## 6 Redirect

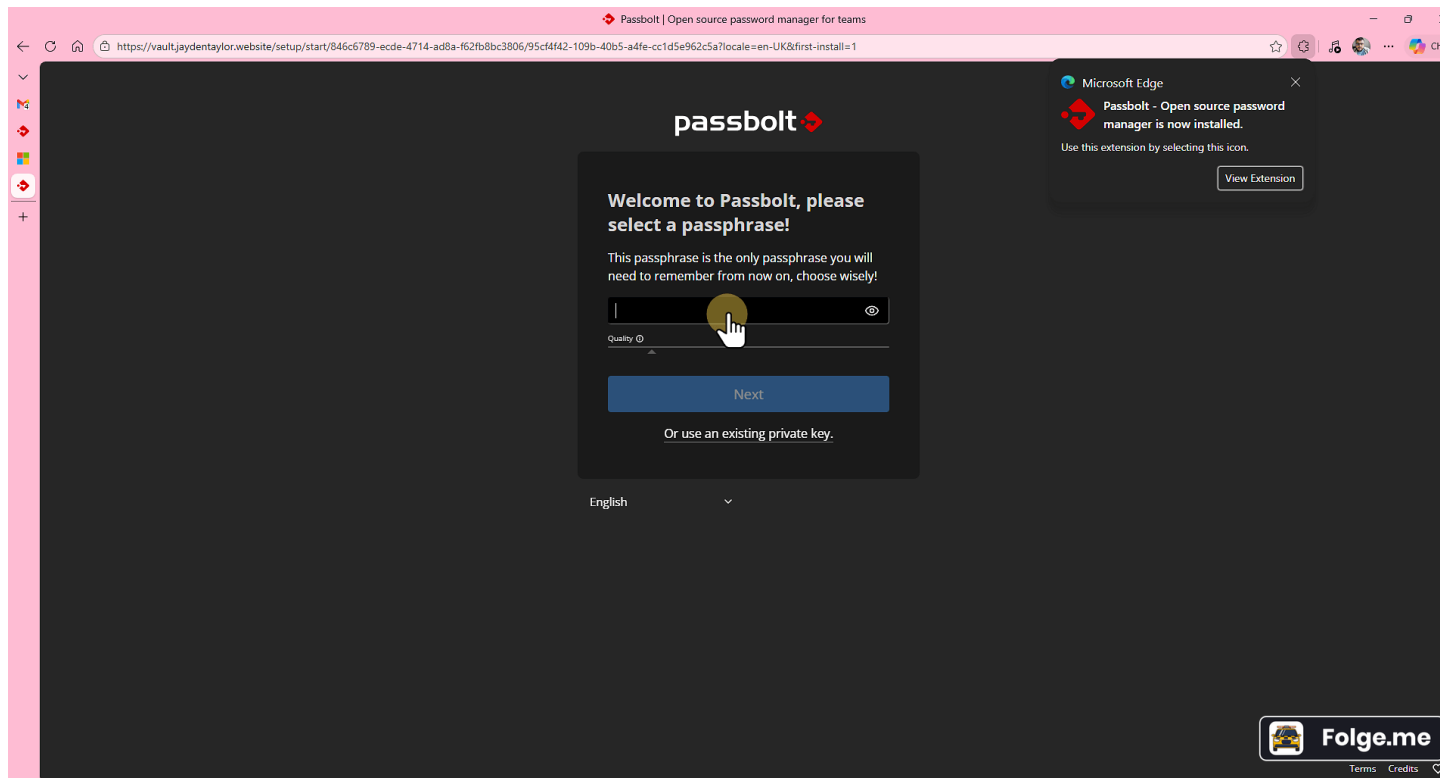
Passbolt will redirect you back to the page to continue setup.



## 7 Passphrase

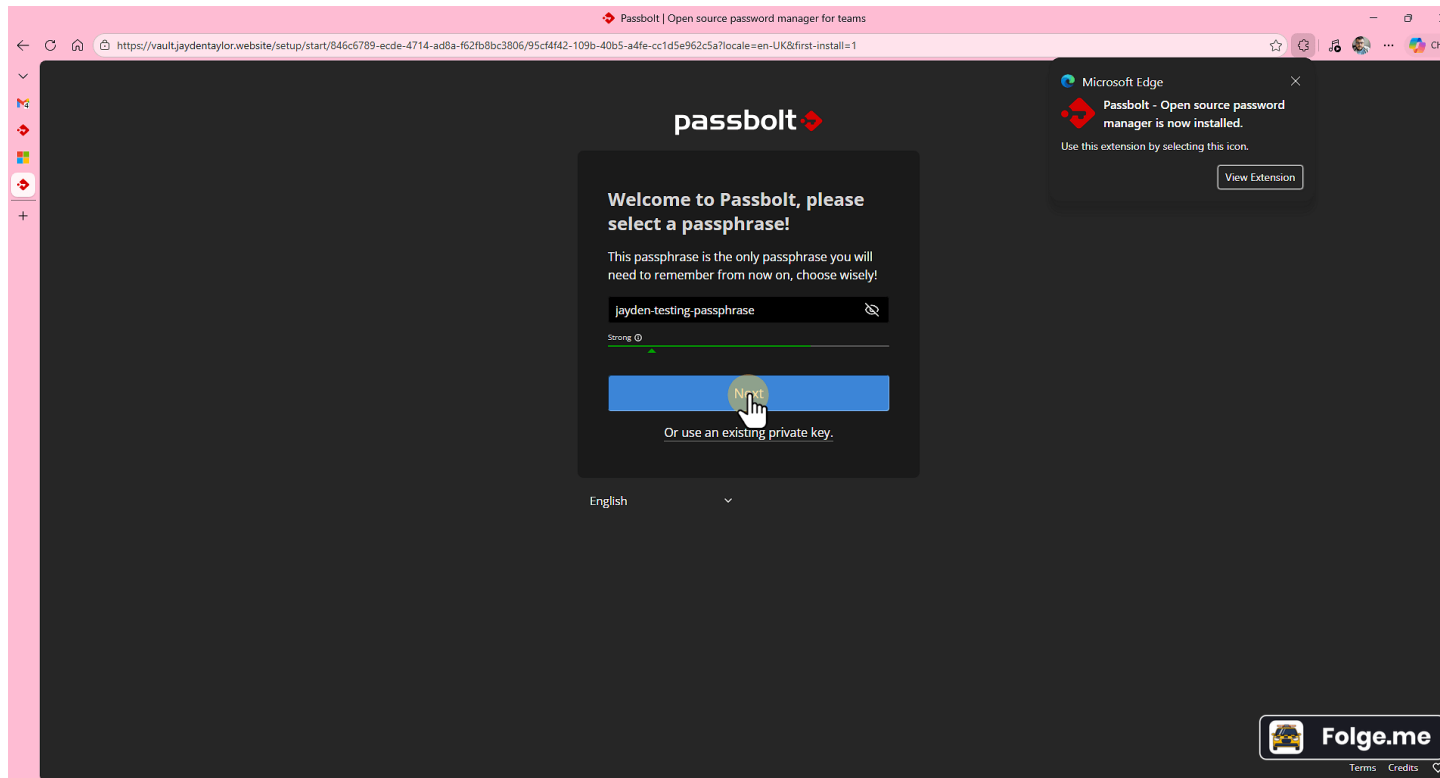
Set up a passphrase. Make it something long, but memorable. For example, jayden-taylor-web-alliance-phrase-cow

Click Next once you've put a passphrase that the system considers at least to be "Strong".

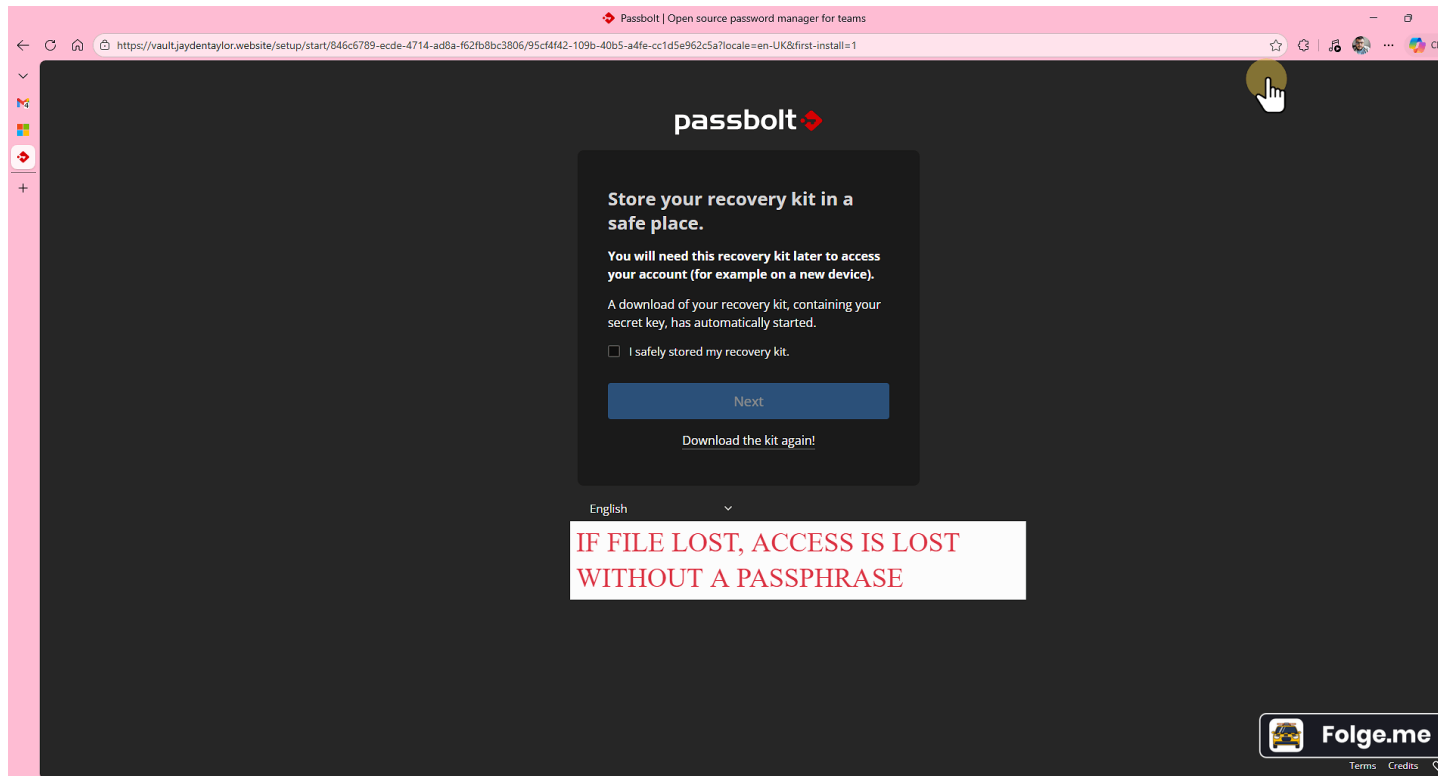


## 9 Recovery Kit



This is a PGP key that can be used once to access the account incase of recovery, or on a new device.

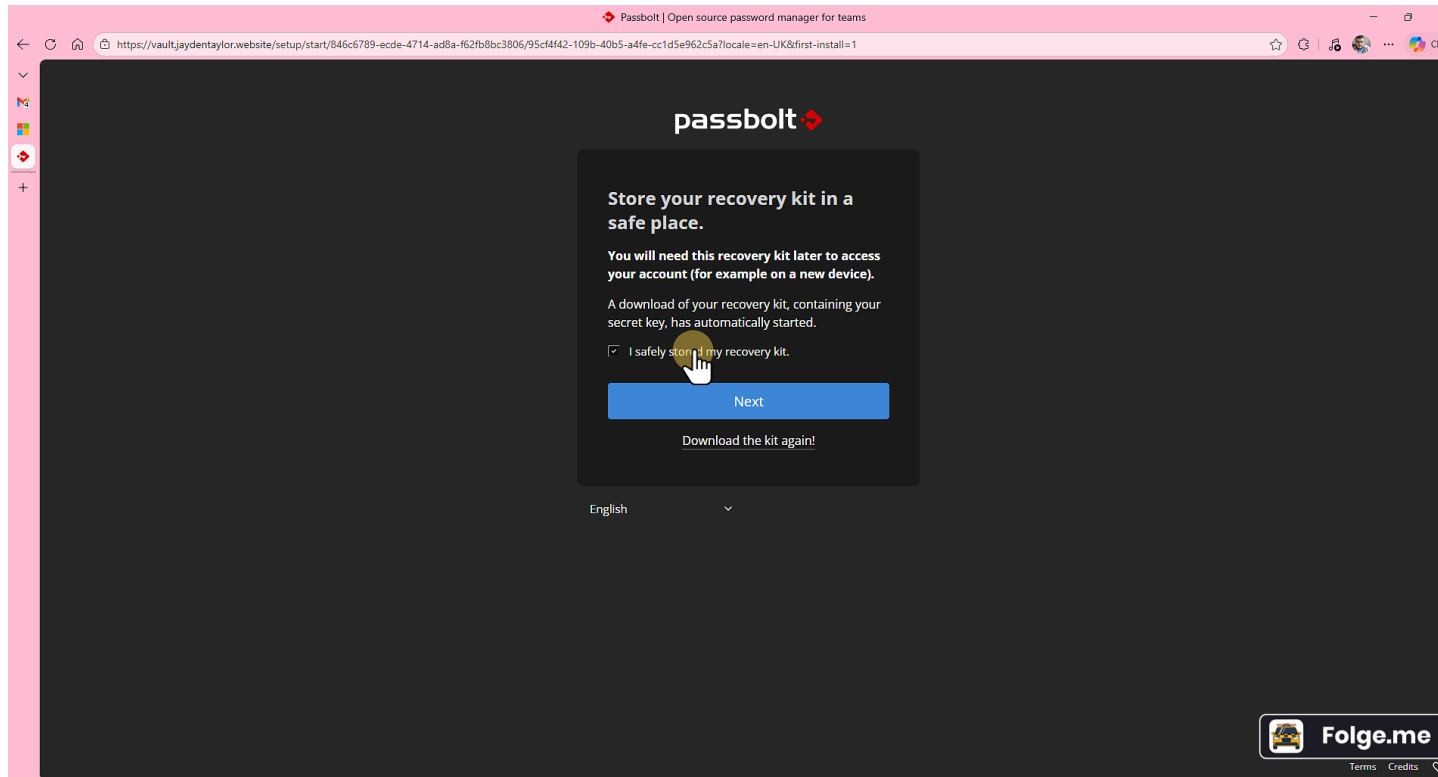
Store it somewhere secure.



## 10 Safely Stored

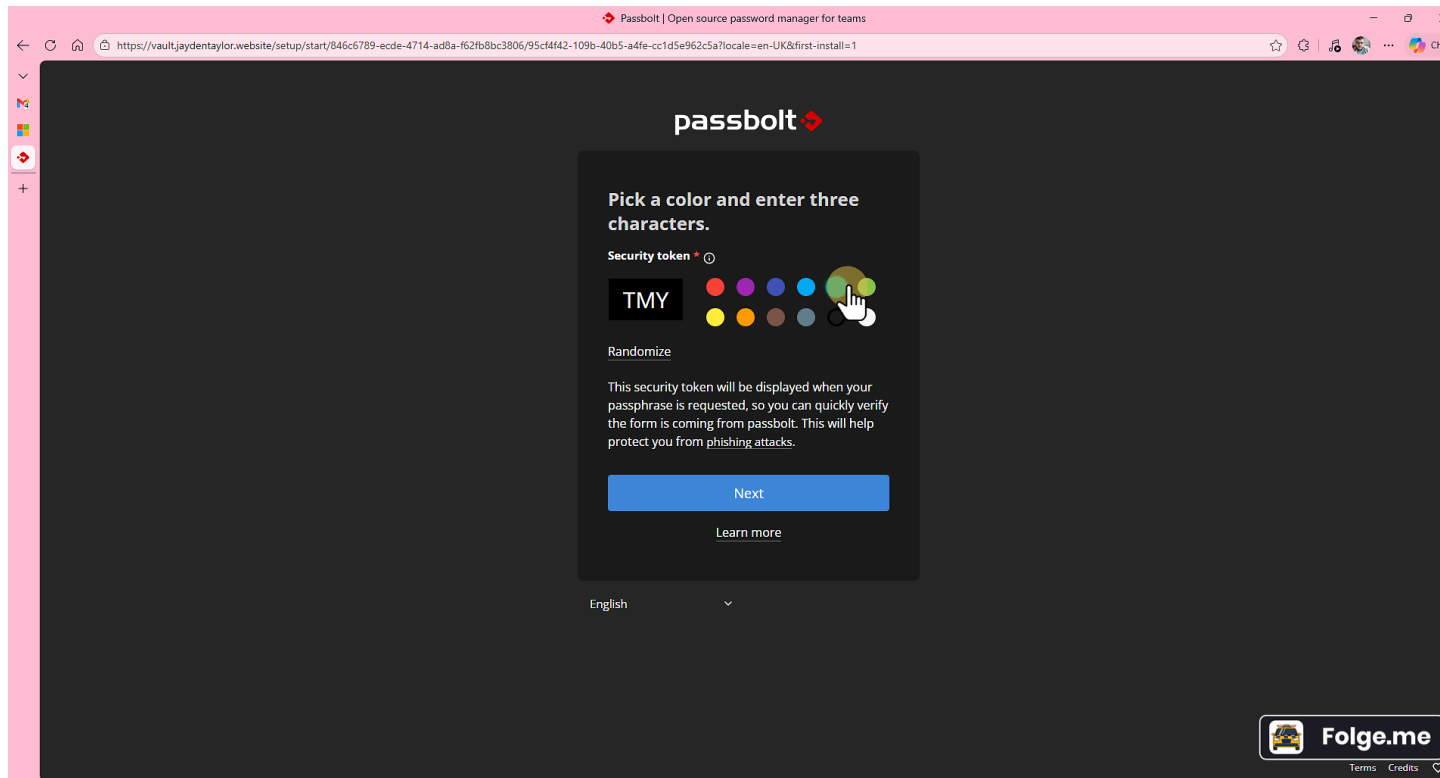
Once you have safely stored the recovery file, click on the checkbox and then on Next.

You can download the file again whilst on this page incase of any issue.



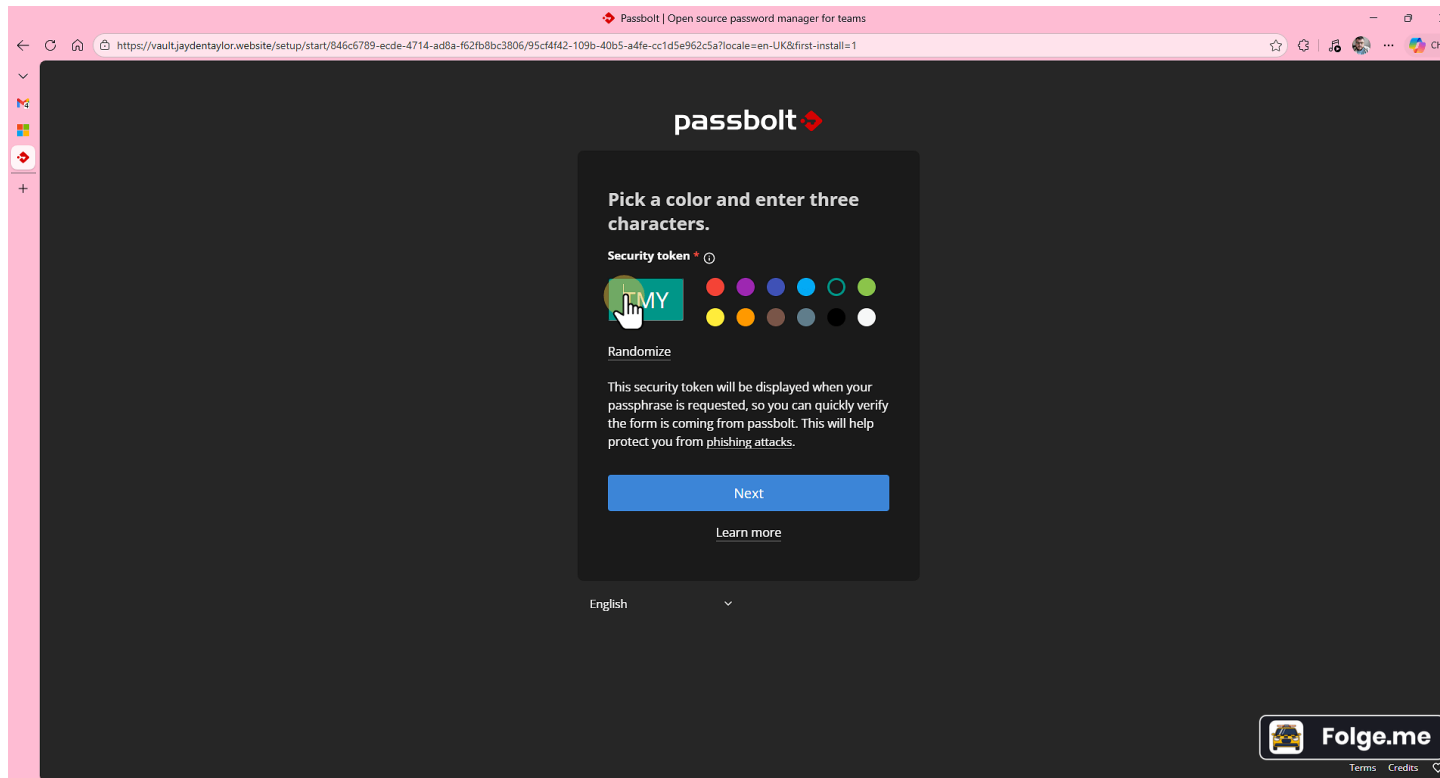
## 11 Security Token
